

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CHECK LIST

Please attach the following documents to your application

- Scholarship Application** - Complete Application with signature and date.
- Letter of Admission** - Undergraduate and graduate students must be admitted to a postsecondary institution accredited by one of six regional accrediting associations as recognized by the Navajo Nation. Graduate applicants must submit a regular Letter of Admission from the graduate college and the graduate degree program. **Enrollment Verification** is required from students who have already submitted a Letter of Admission. Students who have not attended school for two consecutive semesters will need to submit a re-admission letter from their respective institution.
- Current Class Schedule** - to verify credit hours.
- Official Transcript** - Official college, high school transcripts, and/or GED scores. First year applicants must submit final high school transcript with date of graduation. Continuing recipients must submit an official transcript after each semester. Additional transcripts are required from all previous colleges attended.
- Social Security Card** - Copy required at the beginning of every school year.
- Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB)** - Copy required at the beginning of every school year.
- Chapter Voter Registration** - If you are under 18 and ineligible to vote, please bring a copy of your parent(s) voter registration.

ARTICLE 6. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

- (g) The appropriate accrediting association for highly specialized majors including, but not limited to, the National Architectural Accrediting Board for schools of architecture.
- (h) Vocational Institutions chartered by the Navajo Nation.
