

RESOLUTION OF  
THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND COMMISSION  
OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

Requesting of the Hopi Tribe to live up to the Accommodation Agreement by Increasing Sheep Units up to 2,800 for Navajo Families in HPL and Allow for Grazing in Additional Range Units.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 2NNC subsection 853 (B) (1), the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission (NHLCO) of the Navajo Nation Council is authorized to advise the President of the Navajo Nation concerning all matters relating to land use conflicts between the Navajo Nation and the Hopi Tribe, and any claimants in and to lands within the areas described in the Act of June 14, 1934 (48 Stat. 960); and
2. The Hopi Tribe entered into an Accommodation Agreement with Navajo Families, BIA for which the Navajo Tribe is paying for: home sites, sheep units, and 10 acres for farming; and
3. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission believes it is in the best interest of its constituents to support the residents within the (HPL) Hopi Partition Lands in order to meet their basic needs and to support the well-being of these residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Requesting of the Hopi Tribe to honor the Accommodation Agreement by Increasing Sheep Units up to 2,800 for Navajo Families in HPL and Allow for Grazing in Additional Range Units.
